

Most astrology books present the author's preconceived formulations as fact, assembled into wordy paragraphs. What they don't tell you is that these "cookbook" paragraph definitions are actually the author's *interpretations*, much less how they arrived at their conclusions. This book does something different. It gives you the basic parts with which to create your own interpretations. Using this approach, rather than memorizing other people's ideas, you will learn to think conceptually, independently, and creatively. And astrology is an art.

The Language of Astrology can be broken down into the following components ...

PLANETS represent Forces or Energies;

SIGNS represent Styles or Modes of Expression (of the Planetary Forces);

HOUSES represent the Areas of Life in which Forces Express themselves.

Planets = What

Signs = How

Houses = Where

Planets express themselves through Signs, in Houses. Think of the Planet as an unfiltered theater spot light. Think of the Sign as a colored gel that is placed over the light. The original light of the Planet is then *colored* by the Sign through which it shines. Think of the House as the stage onto which the light is projected.

There are 10 Planetary energies, plus the North and South Nodes.

There are 12 possible shades of coloration (Signs).

There are 12 possible contexts of expression (Houses).

The interplay and synthesis of these "parts of speech" add up to Astrological sentences. Learning the rules of grammar of this special language will allow you to create your own personal interpretations – and expand your understanding of life in the process.

Following are the basic building blocks of this complex system, demystified. The pages with three columns are meant to be taken out of this book and copied. You can then cut between each vertical column, making long strips of the lists of keywords. Finally, as you rearrange the three columns side-by-side, you will see new combinations of Planets in Signs in Houses. Let your eye scan up and down the word lists. Let your mind go and see what comes as you free-associate and brainstorm phrases and sentences sparked by the keywords. Soon you will be creating your own meanings to Planets — in Signs — in Houses.







## THE PHILOSOPHY OF MODERN ASTROLOGY

STROLOGY IS A LANGUAGE that describes patterns of energy in symbolic terms. The reason that astrology works is that it is based on the principle of synchronicity. Modern physics and chaos theory are showing us what Eastern and Western mystics have always known: This principle is as deeply embedded within the inherent structure of the universe as the laws and cause and effect. According to the psychologist C.G. Jung, synchronicity is an acausal relationship between events that is meaningful. This connection is based upon the meaningful relationship between events, although they are "coincidental." They are happening at the same time, co-inciding, so one is not causing the other. Actually, events that cause one another cannot be said to be synchronistic. By definition, synchronistic events must be acausal, but connected in a meaningful way. This makes the "observer" (or subject) a crucial factor.

Thus, the stars and planets do not *cause* events on Earth. However, events can be better understood through learning to "read" the symbolic relationships between the planets, stars, and the earthly events occurring simultaneously with celestial events. It is a case of "meaningful coincidence." The two coincide; one does not cause the other. Earthly and celestial events can be said to be analogous to one another, Earth being a microcosm of the macrocosm of the Universe. The two levels can be likened to the gears turning together within a clock. The abstract geometric relationships of the planets are related to not only sun spot activity and weather patters on Earth, but to our own individual lives as well.

The MEANING is in the relationship perceived by the mind through the language of symbols. The only "leap of faith" involved is in exploring the underlying hypothesis that the Universe is inherently synchronistic, and that its interrelationships can be discerned symbolically. "Meaning is in the eye of the beholder." It is a subjective experience. But it is certainly an experience that can be tested empirically. And that is what I invite you to do – test this hypothesis out, experientially, empirically, and above all, subjectively.

Astrology is a tool that taps into the mysterious realm of coincidence, and amplifies that experience in a way that is subjectively meaningful. Astrology is sophisticated enough a system to know that it is subjective. It does not buy into the pseudo-objectivity of the "hard sciences," although statistical research has substantiated the validity of astrology. While yielding some interesting data, for me this kind of exercise is actually beside the point.

If astrology is seen as a "Mirror of Time," a birth chart can be seen as a "snapshot" of celestial relationships at the moment of birth – which is a significant event in Time, creating an "imprint" of that moment. The abstract geometrical patterns of relationship at the time of that event symbolically describe energy patterns that will tend to exist for that individual's lifetime – both as personality and behavior patterns, and as event and relationship patterns. (That is, inner and outer.) But the chart is merely suggesting tendencies, likelihoods, paths of least resistance. What's more, these patterns, and symbols, have many, many possible levels of expression. With work, "problem patterns" can be transformed into strengths and assets: the energies can manifest on "higher levels." The chart does not reveal the actual level of manifestation.

The chart is NOT an "X-Ray of the Soul." It's more a blueprint of the personality (the soul's vehicle) and a map of the life's course (the soul's journey). However, even these are not absolutely written in stone. It is crucial to remember that the chart does not describe the Self. The Self is symbolically located at the center of the chart (representing Earth), and is invisible. It manifests through the chart, but it is not the chart. The Self is beyond any description or language or prediction because it is Divine. The Self has Free Will. While the personality cannot completely "override" or "transcend" the chart, there is a certain amount of choice in the level of expression of the chart. This is where the level of consciousness comes into play. The chart also does not indicate an individual's level of consciousness whatsoever. It is impossible to tell a drug addict from a mystical practitioner with only the chart. Actually, they are closely related astrologically, and C.G. Jung would say, psychologically. After all, a chart can be constructed for the death of a chicken, or the completion of a building or the formation of a company – or the moment you lost your keys.

The highest possible use of astrology is to expand one's consciousness, and thereby to increase the scope of one's Free Will. As the oldest psychology, when used to its fullest, astrology's insights are liberating and empowering, and not deterministic and merely predictive.

Individuals perceive "reality" through their own charts, and each astrologer perceives astrology through the lens of his or her own chart. And every chart an astrologer looks at will be filtered through the patterns of his or her own chart. The level of interpretation is obviously determined by the astrologer's level of awareness and consciousness. While calculating a chart is a science, interpretation is not a science. It is an art.

In studying together, I will be sharing my version of astrology with you as I have come to understand it in my 15 years of study and practice. And I will also encourage you to seek exposure to other approaches and to develop your own unique, individual vision.




